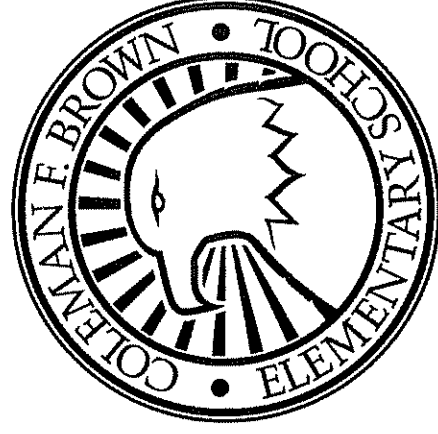


Coleman F. Brown Playground and Equipment Rules



Four Square

1. The ball may hit in each square only once.
2. The next person in line goes to square "A" when someone is out.
3. Stay in your own square.
NOT ALLOWED: Stealing the ball; stepping into another's square

Tetherball

1. Two players in and when the game is over they both go out and two new players come in (2 out - 2 in)
2. Play only one game.
3. The two players will do Rock/Paper/Scissors once to determine who serves the ball.
4. Remain within the drawn lines.
NOT ALLOWED: Grabbing the rope or ball while in play; stepping over the middle line or going out of the circle; swinging on the ball; helps from people in line; chances; bubbles (bouncing the ball in the hands until in position to hit); holding the ball.

Basketball

1. Students waiting to rotate into the game will do so when a team makes a point.
2. Full court games are played with 10 students - Five students on each team only - 5 on 5.
3. Half court games are played with 6 students - Three students on each team only - 3 on 3.
4. Students will number themselves 1 to however many students want to play and rotate in and out. (Example - if there are 10 students, they would number themselves 1-10 and the first five or three would begin the game.)
NOT ALLOWED: Pushing, shoving, hitting, or put-downs.

If students choose to not follow these rules, they will lose part of recess.

If students choose to fight, push, shove, or use any other physical aggression towards another student, the student will have a consequence.

GENERAL PLAYGROUND GUIDELINES

1. Closed games are not allowed.
2. All games requiring the kicking of a ball are to be played on the grass. Balls may not be thrown against the buildings or bounced in walkways.
3. Organized games such as four-square or basketball are to be played in designated areas only.
4. Rocks, bark or other materials may not be thrown.
5. Bikes are not to be ridden on school grounds. Skateboards and scooters do not belong at school.
6. Report any equipment lost over a fence or on a roof to yard duty supervisor.
7. Any injury or playground problems should be reported to a yard duty supervisor or to a teacher.
8. All students must remain in their designated play space.
9. Playing in or around restrooms, hallways and classrooms is NOT ALLOWED.
10. Running is restricted to the field grass areas unless in an organized game.
11. Giving "ups" and "saving places" in lines are not allowed.
12. No student generated rules allowed.

MORNING AND AFTER SCHOOL RULES

1. Students are not allowed on the school grounds prior to 7:45 a.m.
2. Students are to remain in a designated area while waiting for the bus.
3. Classroom lines are to be quietly and orderly.
4. Gum chewing is NOT ALLOWED at any time at school.
5. Students are to go directly home after school except when they must remain on the school grounds for classroom or school business.

EQUIPMENT USAGE

Rubber Balls – These are used only for games such as 4-square, wall ball, and catching games.
Soccer Balls – These are used for games such as soccer, kickball, and games that are on the grass.
Basketball – These are to be used for basketball games only.
Jump Ropes – Students are to play jump rope only.

PLAYGROUND RULES

For All Games

If there is a conflict, two students will do Rock/Paper/Scissors.

- Rock wins over Scissors
- Paper wins over Rock
- Scissors win over Paper

Big Toy

1. Use both hands on the bars.
2. Students will go in one direction on the hanging rings and monkey bars starting at the platform.
3. Six students on the top platform at a time.
4. One student going down the slide at a time.
5. Students will not climb up the slide.
6. Students will use two hands and go down the pole only.
7. No chicken fights.
8. Students will be moving at all times, no sitting allowed.

4/5 Big Toy

1. Use both hands on the bars.
2. Students go in one direction on the apparatus.
3. Four students on the top platform at a time.
4. Students are to climb up the rock-climbing wall.
5. No twirling on bars, they are for chin-ups only.
6. Students will be moving at all times, no sitting allowed.

Wall Ball

Games may include the use of rubber balls only.

NOT ALLOWED: Throwing the ball at a person or persons; climbing over the wall; kicking or throwing any object over the wall; kicking any object at the wall.

Kick Ball Basketball

Will only be played under the supervision of the classroom teacher.
